



# Weatherization Assistance Program Income Eligibility

Households may be eligible if their household income is 60% or less of the State Median Income (SMI) or 80% or less of their county’s Area Median Income (AMI). Income limits to qualify are determined based on whichever of these income indicators is higher. Note that income limits for households with eight or more people are based on 200% of the federal poverty line (FPL) instead of SMI.
